II Application Eligibility

1. Eligibility for applicant

- A.** An applicant holding foreign citizenship and both parents are also foreign citizens(must not Korean citizens)
- B.** Overseas Korean applicants residing in foreign countries or foreigners who have completed their entire elementary, middle school, high school and undergraduate education outside of Korea
- 1) An applicant who wants to apply for the admission for international students must satisfy at

least one of requirements above. An applicant who satisfies both of them is regarded as the eligibility **A**.

- 2) An applicant who satisfies one of above conditions must submit documents that can prove the eligibility of **A** or **B**.
- 3) If an applicant or his/her parents are dual nationality holder with Korean citizenship, applicant will not be allowed to apply for International students admission.
- 4) Applicants who are not applicable to above two conditions must apply for domestic students admission, not international students admission.

※ **Applicants from different fields of study can also apply and must complete certain supplementary units until graduation**

※ **Among professors in Daegu Catholic University are not allowed to apply for the Graduate School.**

2. Eligibility for applicant

A. Master's/Integrated Master's & Doctorate course

- 1) One who holds a Bachelor's degree
- 2) One who is supposed to get Bachelor's degree until the end of February, 2020.
- 3) According to the relevant law, those who have received a Master's degree or been recognized as having the equivalent academic experience.

B. Doctorate course

- 1) One who holds a Master's degree
- 2) One who is supposed to get Master's degree until the end of February, 2020.
- 3) According to the relevant law, those who have received a Master's degree or been recognized as having the equivalent academic experience.
- 4) Department of Culture Spirituality Eligibility : Obtaining a master's degree in theology major (plan) and the Catholic party

C. Language Requirements

International applicants must meet one of below Language proficiency test score.(Only Humanities/Sociology applicants)

V Application Review procedure

1. Document Review Screening

- A. The admissions committee of each department, which consists of two faculty members who are in charge of the graduate school lectures and related to the major or the applicant, reviews applications and recommends candidates to the Graduate School.
- B. If necessary, interview(by phone or etc.) can be conducted upon departments' requests and it may be include performance test in Arts Majors

- ※ As a rule all documents submitted must be originals. If the original documents are not written by Korean or English, translation in Korean or English must be attached.
- ※ Applicants who failed to submit all required documents will be disqualified.

2. Visa Issue

- ① Sojourn status : D-2
- ② Where to Apply : Local Korean Embassy or Consulate

③ Procedure

- 1) Daegu Catholic University mails admission materials, including "Certificate of Admission," or "invitation" to applicants in order to apply for "Student Visa".
- 2) Applicants apply for "Student Visa" with the required documents at the Korean Embassy or at the Korean Consulate in the applicant's country.
- 3) Applicants obtain "Student Visa" (D-2), and enter Korea.

▶ **Students with a D-2 visa who wish to stay in Korea for more than 90 days must visit a local immigration office or branch office and apply for an alien registration card within 90 days of entry in Korea.**
